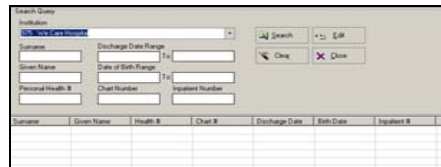

The Search Query screen will appear:

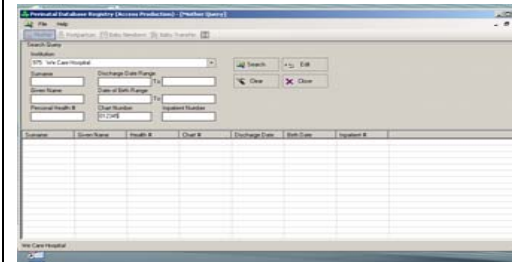


Only records from the active institution will be found.
