Revised Reference Manual

A revised version of the BCPDR Reference Manual will be rolled out effective April 1, 2014. The following will be covered during the webinar training session:

- High-level changes to manual format
 - Manual to be posted on the website with hyperlinks
 - Changes and additions are clearly marked
 - Contains many new explanations, examples, and clarifications
- Major changes to manual content
 - Definition of episode of care for cases involving home deliveries by midwives who are admitted to hospital within 24 hours
 - Clarification of the definition of stillborn in BC and the collection of the information in the PDR
- Rollout of NICU classification – information forthcoming
- Training
 - Two training sessions available via Webinar **AND** Teleconference line (i.e. you will need to log on to a computer as well as dial in by phone)
