

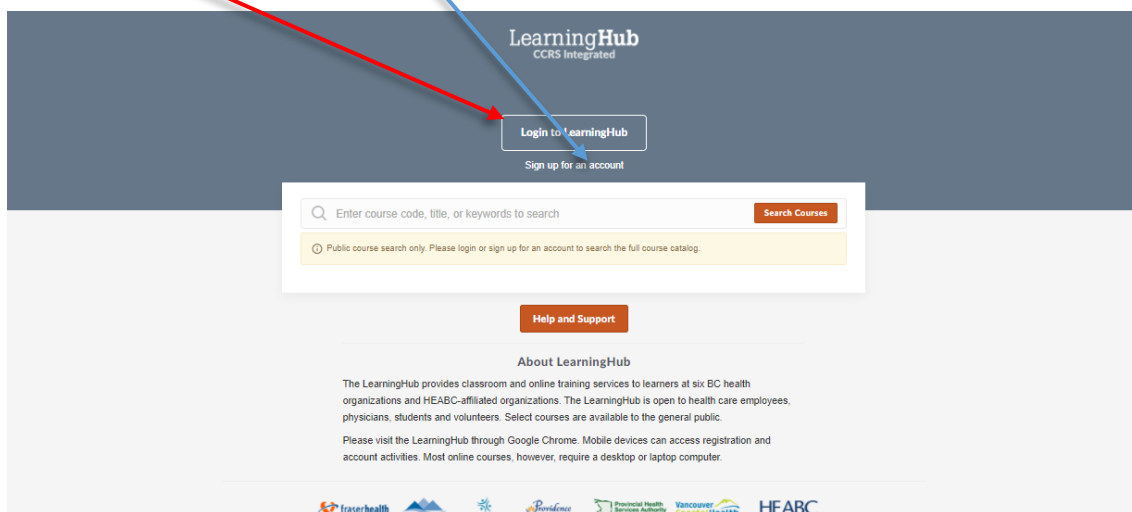
HOW TO ACCESS OTAS EDUCATION:

The modules are now available via the Learning Hub.

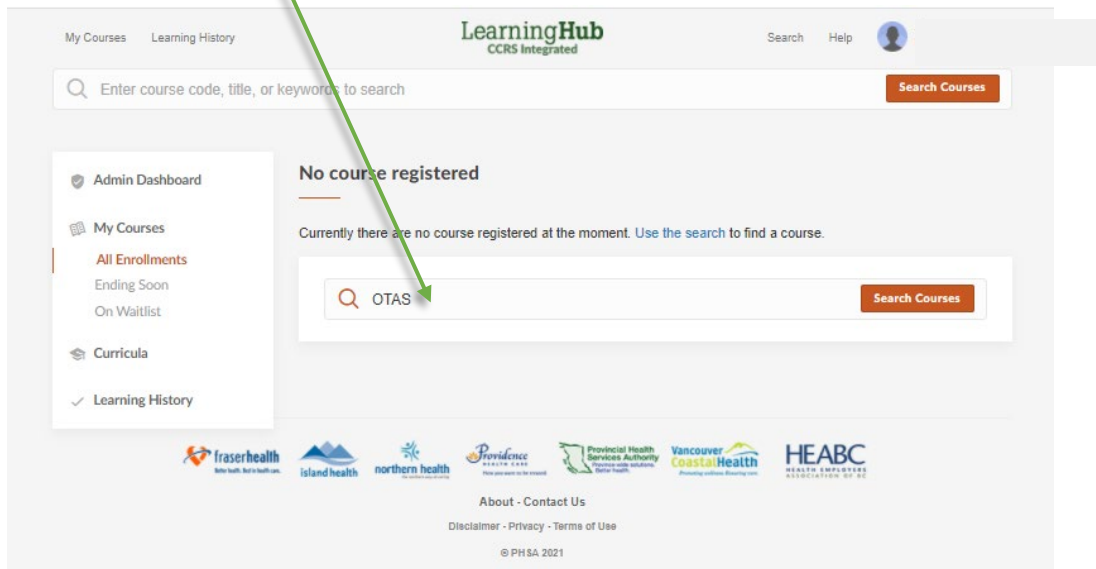
To access 'Obstetric Triage Acuity Scale' education please follow these steps.

Log into Learning Hub (create an account if you do not have one already)



In the search field type in OTAS
