1. Meet eligibility criteria to attend NRP Instructor workshop as outlined above.
2. Submit proof of successful completion of an Advanced NRP Provider Course and online NRP exam 12 months before the NRP Instructor Workshop.
3. Successful completion of an individual integrated skills station assessment (ISSA) evaluated by a BC NRP Instructor Trainer.
4. Participation in the two-day NRP Instructor Workshop on: _____
5. Actively participate in at least one NRP Provider workshop before the Team Teach.
6. Successfully complete a team teach of an NRP Provider course supervised by an NRP Instructor Trainer within six months from the date of the NRP Instructor Workshop. PSBC only support two team teaches. Additional team teaches, if required, can happen after discussion between PSBC, the NRP Instructor Trainer, and representative of sponsoring institution.
